

## LTC Nathan Showman

LTC Nathan (Nate) Showman is a native of Cincinnati, OH. He was commissioned an Infantry officer through Army ROTC at Xavier University in 2005. Following completion of training at Fort Benning, GA, he was assigned to 2-16 IN, 4/1 ID(L) at Fort Riley, KS where he served from 2006-2008. He led both Rifle and Scout Platoons, and deployed with 2-16 IN to Baghdad, Iraq from February 2007 to April 2008.

Upon completion of the Captain's Career Course at Fort Benning, GA, LTC Showman was assigned to 2-23 IN, 4/2 SBCT at Joint Base Lewis-McChord (JBLM), WA from 2009-2012. He deployed to Camp Taji, Iraq, with 2-23 IN from September 2009 – August 2010. He commanded A Company, 2-23 IN followed by command of HHC, 2-23 IN.

From 2012-2013, LTC Showman attended Indiana University where he completed a Masters of Science in Kinesiology. Subsequently, he was assigned to the United States Military Academy at West Point from 2013-2016, where he taught in the Department of Physical Education. He served primarily as a combatives instructor and was the Officer In-Charge and Assistant Coach of the West Point Powerlifting Team.

LTC Showman attended ILE at Fort Leavenworth, KS from 2016-2017. After PCS to Vicenza, Italy, he was assigned as the Operations Officer for 2-503 PIR. He led a training deployment to the Republic of Georgia from May-August 2019 in support of the Georgia Defense Readiness Project – Training, and completed a variety of other training missions in support of SETAF. Following his assignment as the Executive Officer for 2-503 PIR, LTC Showman moved to the United Kingdom, where he served from 2019-2021 as the US Exchange Officer to the Parachute Regiment (UK) and Officer Commanding D Company, 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion The Parachute Regiment. LTC Showman deployed to Afghanistan from January-April 2020, where he served as the G3/5 for the Kabul Security Force.

LTC Showman returned to the US in 2021. He served as the Combined Arms Detachment Chief and as the Chief of the Command Planning Group within the Soldier Support Institute at Fort Jackson, SC, before PCS to Dahlonaga, GA and Camp Frank D. Merrill.

Everett, LTC Showman's son, is six and lives in Fort Thomas, KY. LTC Showman enjoys Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu, all disciplines of cycling, and a multitude of other physical activities. His awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal, Combat and Expert Infantry Badges, Ranger Tab, Senior Parachutist's Badge, and Air Assault Badge.
